HOTEL

Each ConFest 2024 guest is responsible for booking their accommodations. We have partnered with the Romer Waikiki at the Ambassador (only 2 miles from the university, 9 minutes by car) to bring you a special discount rate when booking your stay.

Visit www.romerwaikiki.com and input the code **CAATA** during the booking process for a room rate of **\$170 per/night**.

Amenities provided by Romer Waikiki at the Ambassador:

- Fitness center
- Coffee/tea in your room
- Happy Hour nightly in the lobby (one complimentary drink per guest)
- Access to beach cruiser bikes
- Discounts on pool cabana rentals

PARKING

At the hotel

Parking at the Romer Waikiki is valet only—priced at \$51 dollars per day plus tax. Their parking lot is located in a secure location and thus requires hotel staff to park incoming vehicles themselves

At the university

CAATA and the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa have partnered to provide all-day parking passes (so you don't have to worry about moving your car) for patrons attending ConFest 2024. To receive your parking pass, email confestcoordinator@caata.net and one of our team of coordinators will be able to assist you.

Parking near the Kennedy Theatre is available via street parking on East-West Road, as well as behind the theatre.

If not purchasing a pass from CAATA, hourly and daily rates are available for purchase at nearby stalls. Note that this is for green spaces only.
